

## **Dolphin Programs: Must make reservations at least 48 hours in advance!**

### **• Meet and Greet a Dolphin- (mini session on a dock)**

- Available at 10:30am and 2:30pm
- Monday –Saturday: April-October (summer season)
- Book Max 3 participants
- Total time on dock is 5 minutes
- Program for start to finish is approximately 1 hour including:
  - ❖ Make sure proper shoes are worn
  - ❖ Preparatory & information session before getting on the dock
  - ❖ Meet and Greet time (5min): feeding, touching, photo option
  - ❖ Behavior to kiss a dolphin for a photo opportunity printed 5x7
  - ❖ Sea Lion Presentation

### **❖ Requirements:**

- \$45 per person due at time of booking
- Children ages 5-7 ***must be*** accompanied by a paying adult who will be kneeling on the dock next to the child. Children must be 5 years of age at time of booking to participate.
- 8yrs old and up can participate without an adult
- Participant must be able to kneel on the dock for at least 5 minutes
- Anyone accompanying the participant, but not participating in the dolphin experience, must pay a spectator fee of \$11 to be allowed to watch at pool side and be able to take photos.
- Must call ext. 1763 to make a reservation with a coupon or gift certificate
- Once you start booking online, you have 10 minutes to complete your transaction or you risk losing your reservation

### **Itinerary:**

10:30-10:45am- Check in for Program, Sign a program waiver, Go over rules and regulations

11:00am- Meet and Greet with a Dolphin: an abbreviated dolphin encounter with the opportunity to feed, touch, one behavior and a posed photo opportunity

11:05am- Watch a dolphin presentation

11:20am- Watch a sea lion presentation

11:45am- Program wraps up with you receiving printed photo of experience

### **What to bring!**

- Shoes must have straps around the back of the heel. No flip flops.
- Clothes that you may get splashed in and are comfortable to kneel in.
- No hats, sunglasses, cameras/phones should be worn or brought onto dock.
